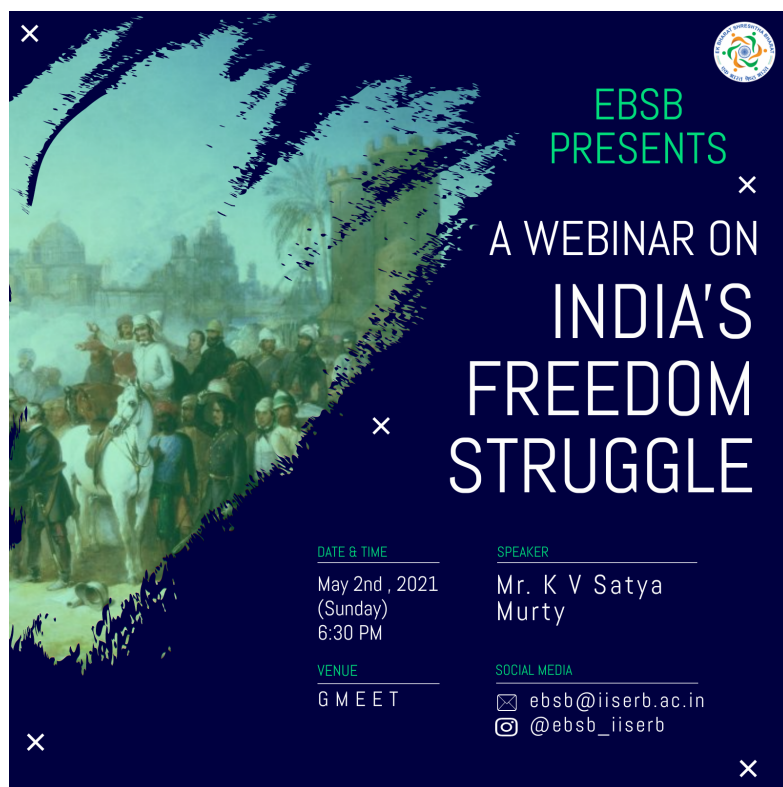
Name of the Event : Webinar on India's freedom struggle

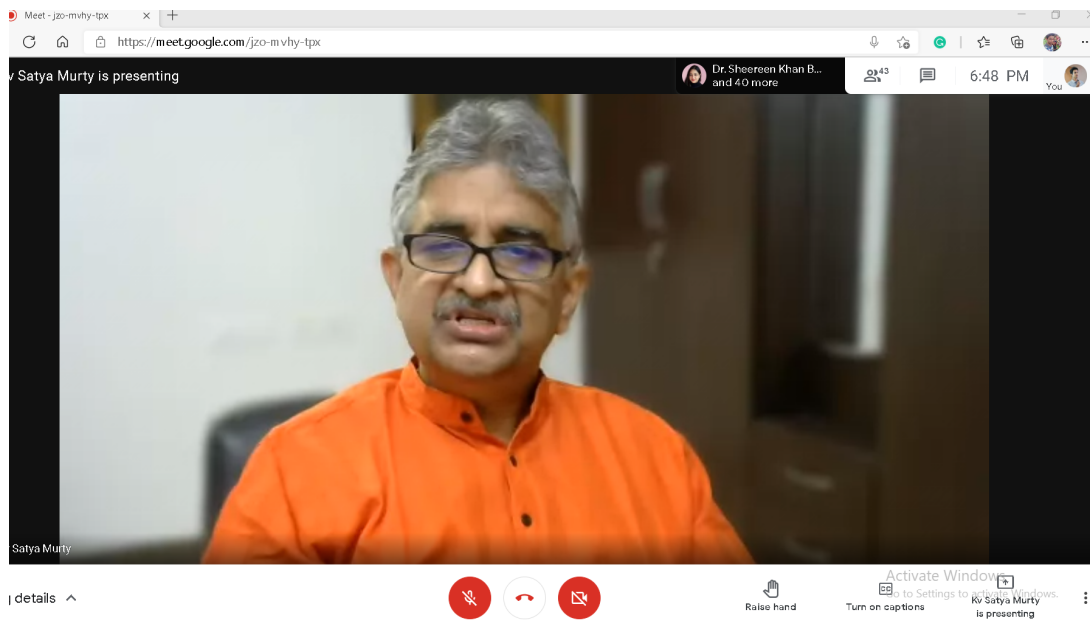

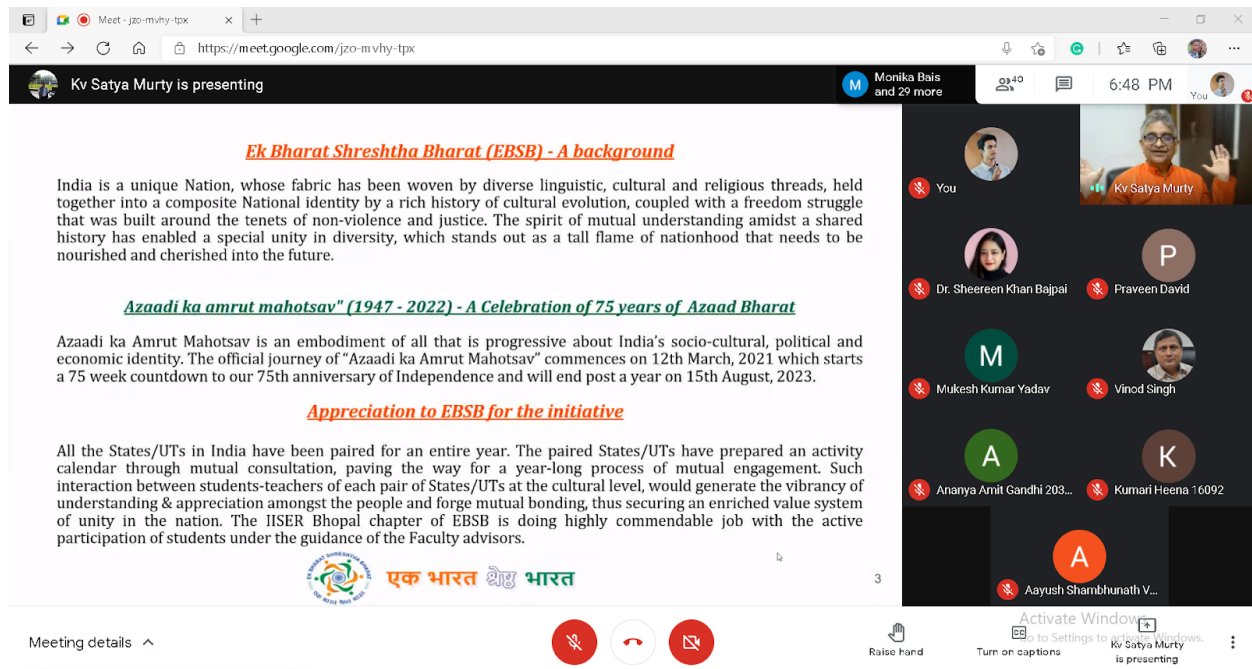

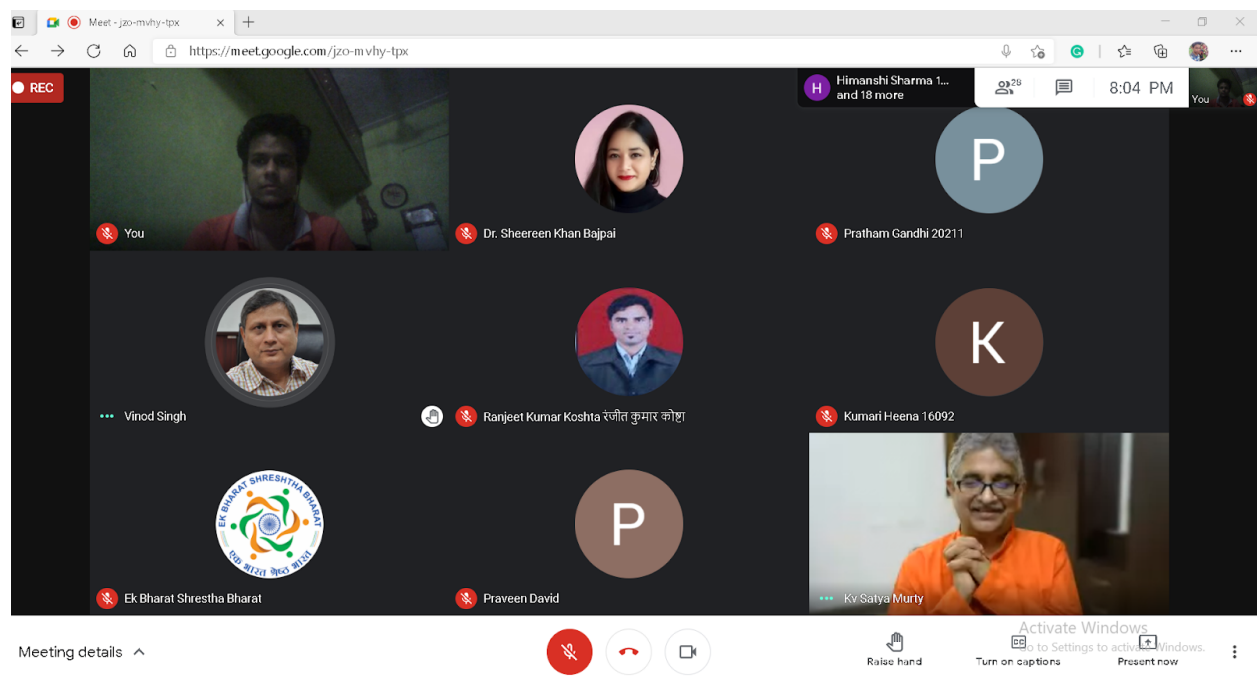
