
Sir/Madam,

NVS is in receipt of a D.O. letter from Secretary, Deptt. of School Education & Literacy regarding activities to be organised under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme during the coming year. It is directed to integrate these activities in regular school activities without any need for extra classes. Incentives / recognition may be given to students for good performances in ESB activities. Further, vide F.No.1-7/2019-IS.5 dated 15.11.19 and 28.11.19, Guidelines for activities and a proposed Calendar has also been received from MHRD (copy enclosed). Schools are to organise these activities as per the calendar shared by MHRD and in coordination with partner states as per pairing pattern of migration linkage.

Accordingly, a revised calendar and list of activities for schools under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat is enclosed.

2. The JNVs are required to maintain a report of activities conducted under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat in the form of a quarterly and annual school report. These reports along with atleast two photos and one short video of each activity is to be collected by the RO and submit a consolidated quarterly report starting from November, 2019 and annual report upto June, 2020. These reports are to be collected and consolidated at NVS HQrs. Consolidated quarterly reports and annual reports of NVS along with filtered photos and videos need to be sent to MHRD in prescribed format.

A Nodal Officer is to be nominated to coordinate the programme with MHRD and the name, designation and contact no. and e-mail ID has to be shared with MHRD. Accordingly, competent authority has nominated Dr.Usha Kumari M.C., AC(Acad.III) as Nodal officer at HQrs. for coordinating, monitoring and reporting purpose. Similarly, all ROs has to nominate one Nodal officer at RO level who will check and approve the data (short videos/photos/ reports) received from JNVs and forward to NVS HQrs. The Nodal Officer at HQrs. in turn will check and approve the data received from RO and will report to MHRD.




Therefore, you are requested to

1. Nominate one Nodal Officer and share name, designation, contact no. and e-mail ID with DC(Acad.), NVS HQrs.
2. JNVs has to follow same migration linkage for pairing of JNVs. ROs has to submit consolidated quarterly reports starting from November, 2019 and annual report upto June, 2020 to NVS,HQrs. The proforma for report as Annexure-B attached to the Guidelines is to be followed while sending consolidated report from RO.
3. For reporting and monitoring, MHRD has suggested Method A (under Guidelines) till development of a portal for Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat. After development of the portal by MHRD, Method B is to be followed (under Guidelines) and report format as Annexure-C is to be followed.
