Water sources are protected; Medicinal Plants for various traditional health treatments are preserved; provide a safe refuge for various animal species; is a source of fuel (as firewood) for domestic use and for earning a livelihood; etc. Unfortunately, sacred groves have no legal protection. Around 14,000 sacred groves have been reported from all over India. This tradition is not only observed in Meghalaya but elsewhere in the Country and the World. The theme of the Webinar gain importance due to the fact that with the need for development and growth of the modern society, the vision of the forefathers in connection with Environmental Protection and Preservation will disappear along with the sacred forest if awareness and discussion is not undertaken for the benefit of the individual and the society at large.

Therefore the National Webinar on the theme “Sacred Groves: Tradition meets Nature” was organised by the EBSB Committee of the College on 22nd October, 2021 from 10:00am onwards where participant from different Colleges and University from within the state of Meghalaya and also from the different paired Institutions from Uttar Pradesh were invited to participate. Awareness and discussion on the important topics related to the theme were focused. The Chief Guest of the Inaugural Programme is Shri. B.K.Lyngwa, IFS, Principal Chief Conservator of Forest & HoFF, Meghalaya Forest and Environment Department. The resource persons in the Webinar were Prof. Desmond L. Kharmawphlang, Cultural & Creative Studies Department, NEHU, Shillong, Dr. C.S.Rao, Associate Professor, Dept. of Botany, St. Anthony’s College, Shillong, Dr. Benjamin Lyngdoh, Assistant Professor, Tourism and Hotel Management Department, NEHU Shillong and Mr. S.Surong, Assistant Professor, B.T.T.M, Lady Keane College, Shillong.



The webinar tried to introduce to all the participants the unique traditions and folklores of the Khasi, Jaintia and Garo people residing in the hills of Meghalaya in relation to nature in general and forest in particular. Prof. Desmond did an outstanding job in highlighting all the important and unique aspects *Folklore in Khasi, Jaintia & Garo community in relation to Sacred Groves*.

The Webinar also tried to understand the impact of Sacred Groves on plant biodiversity. Dr.C.Satyajit Rao gave a detail presentation on the topic *Sacred Groves and Medicinal Plants* and highlighted the different varieties of plant species that has been documented since the British era that are present in Sacred Groves. Dr. Rao also gives pictorial evidence of the different medicinal plant that have been preserved due to the preservation and protection of Sacred Groves.

The Webinar also aims to understand the impact of Preserving and Protecting Forest on the local economy. Dr. Benjamin gave a thorough lecture on the topic *Sacred Groves: Impact on Local Economy* and highlighted the merits and demerits of linking sacred groves to improve the economy of the place where Sacred Groves are present.

Mr. Sushant Surong gave a short presentation on how anyone can visit and experience the wonders of the Sacred Groves in Meghalaya. The presentation was very detailed and clear to everyone.

All the technical session was highly informative and interesting. All the resource persons were very well versed with the topics that were entrusted to them and their lecture and subsequent interaction with the participants was very insightful as can be observed from the feedback of the participants. The Webinar as a whole as commended by the participants was very good.

ABOUT THE RESOURCE PERSONS

Prof. Desmond L. Kharmawphlang is a poet and folklorist. He also writes short stories. He has published collections of poetry and books on folklore and folkloristics. He has also collected, compiled and edited folk narratives and folk songs of North East India. An Associate Member of the Folklore Fellows instituted by the Finnish Academy of Science and Letters, he was on the executive board of the Belief Narrative Network of the International Society for Folk Narrative Research from 2011-21. He has held teaching positions as Visiting Professor at various universities in India, (**D**elhi University, Central University of Hyderabad) and abroad (Oregon State University, U.S.A., Helsinki University, Finland, Hellenic American University, Greece, Qinghai Institute of Social Sciences, China), the latest being the Dyason Visiting Fellowship at Melbourne University, (2018), the Ca Foscari University in Venice (2019) and the University of South Wales in Cardiff, in the U.K.(2019). He teaches folkloristics at North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong, in the state of Meghalaya. He is Principal Investigator of the project **Protecting Endangered Heritage in the Abode of Clouds**, a project undertaken in collaboration with Melbourne University and sponsored by the British Library. He is also supervising a North Eastern Council, Government of India Project on **Folklore, Wildlife and Nature**.

Dr. Benjamin F. Lyngdoh did his graduation and master in commerce and specializes in accountancy and finance. He did his PhD in the area of *development studies* on a topic concerning *microfinance and women empowerment*. He has a professional experience of more than fifteen years in disseminating and discussing accountancy, finance, management, economics, human resources, marketing, entrepreneurship, tourism, development studies and related areas. His area of interest in research continues to be development studies in general and tourism impact evaluations in particular. He completed a UGC, New Delhi sponsored research project in 2011 and an ICSSR, New Delhi sponsored research project in 2017. He has thirty research publications in journals/edited books and has presented paper in more than thirty-seven seminars/conferences.

Dr. C. Satyajit Rao did his graduate and post graduate education in Shillong and completed his Ph.D from NEHU, Shillong. He has been teaching Botany for the last 33 years and is presently serving as the Head of Department of Botany in St. Anthony's College, Shillong. He had also served as scientist-in-charge of Bio-resources development Center (BRDC), Shillong for two years. Dr. Rao has travelled widely covering most parts of



Meghalaya. His specialization is on microbial ecology and ectomycorrhizae. His interests are photography, gardening of wild ornamentals, local orchids, medicinal plants and other wild plants of Meghalaya. He has published 13 research papers and two books so far and made 24 presentations in various national and International symposia and seminars on various aspects of biodiversity. He has published a popular book titled **Wild orchids of Meghalaya**.

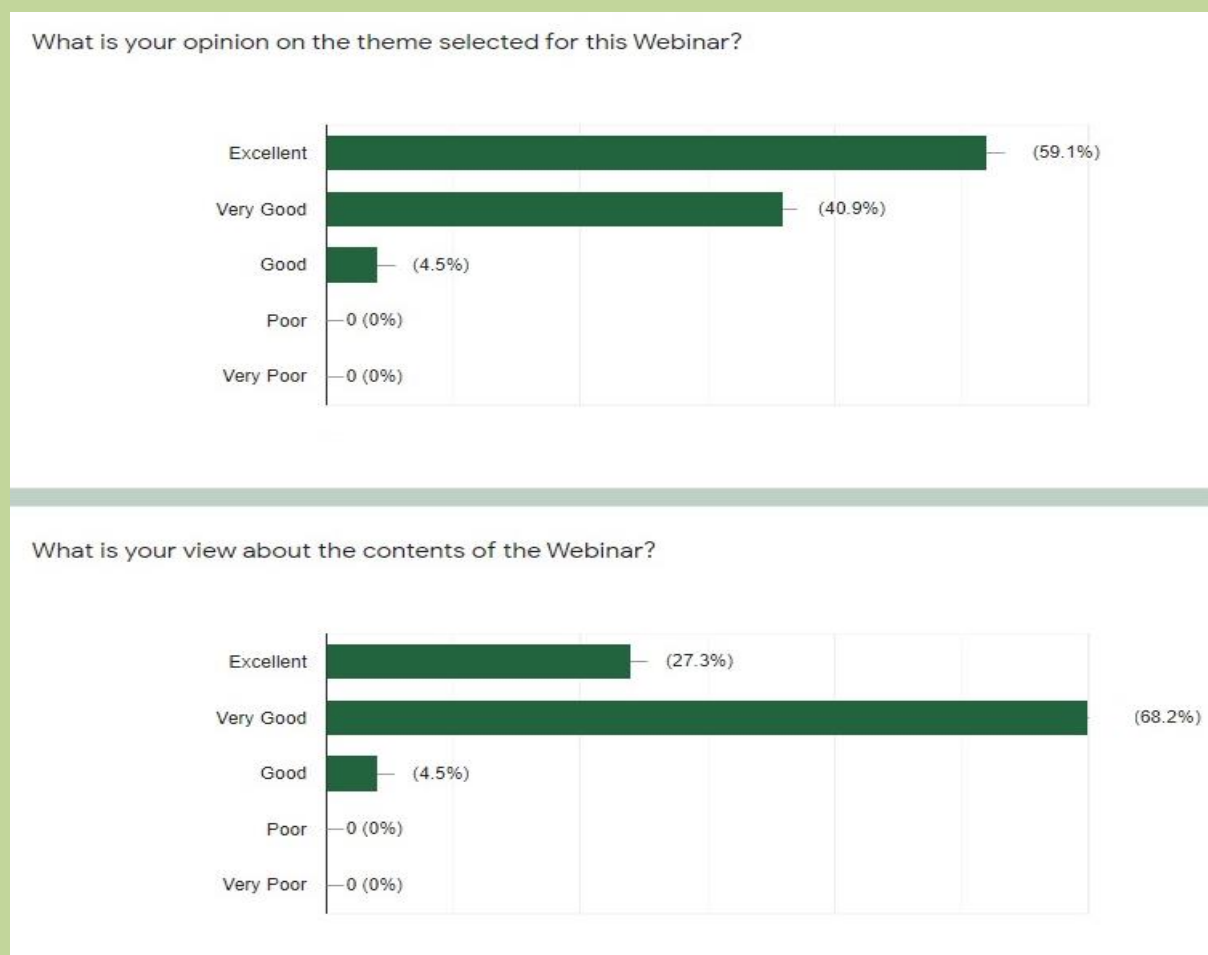
