Girls perform the Loor during the month of 'Phalguna' (spring). This dance is named so because the word 'Loor' means girl in the Bhangra area of Haryana. It is specially performed during the Holi festival. This dance marks the arrival of pleasant spring season and with it the sowing of the Rabi crops in the farms. Girl cadets of this school dressed in traditional costume of Haryana kept viewers spell bound with their mesmerizing Loor dance. Haryana is rich in musical tradition. The Indian state of Haryana has produced a number of kinds of folk music, and has also produced innovations in Indian classical music. Not only this even places have been named after ragas, for example Charkhi Dadri district has many villages named as Nandyam, Sarangpur, Bilawala, Brindabana, Todi, Asaveri, Jaisri, Malakoshna, Hindola, Bhairvi and Gopi Kalyana. There are many different folk singing styles prevalent in Haryana like Gharwa Gayan, Jhoolana, Patka, Rasia, etc. These styles differ from each other in the way they are sung or performed by folk singers of different areas of the state. Similarly ballads are very important section of folk music. They don't generally have lyrical qualities of folk poetry as in songs instanced above. They are the unwritten history of community. The costumes of the dancers reflect the love of the people for bright colours and finery. The women wear a calf length Ghagra made from at least twenty meters of fabric. This is topped by a short kurti. Covering their heads and the conical ornament called choonda is the Chundaria glittering with tinsel. On the forehead is a round knob like ornament called Borta. The ears have thee Karan Phool. The neck is bedecked with a solid silver neck let called Hansli and a necklace called Kanthia. The wrists have Kangans and silver anklets tinkle on the feet. The hands glitter with silver Hathphools. The men wear Dhotis and bright Kurtas caught in at the waist with sashes, in contrasting colours. Their turbans of different colours complete the picture. News Reading on the partner State On 27 Oct 2021, a group of cadets read news from Haryana covering sports, politics, agriculture. The headlines of the news with their details are as follows: 1.
