Speaking on the occasion Mr Mishra underlined the relevance and importance of the Indian constitution which can be summarised as under: Today, most countries in the world have a Constitution. There can be several purposes for drafting a constitution, they are: (a) To provide a set of basic rules that allow for minimal coordination amongst members of society. (b) To specify who has the power to make decisions in a society. It decides how the government will be constituted. (c) To set some limits on what a government can impose on its citizens. These limits are fundamental in the sense that government may never trespass on them. (d) To enable the government to fulfill the aspirations of a society and create conditions for a just society. Therefore, it can be understood that the constitution allows coordination and assurance. On the other hand, it can limit the powers of the government. The Vice Principal of the School in her Presidential Remarks threw light on the relevance of the Constitution and said that it is a living document. Like a living being, the Constitution responds to experience. Even after so many changes in society, the Constitution continues to work effectively because of its ability, to be dynamic, to be open to interpretations and the ability to respond to the changing situation. She said that it is a hallmark of a democratic constitution. Mr S K Biswal, PGT, the Senior Master of the School proposed the vote of thanks. Speaking on the occasion he remarked that the Constitution of India has borrowed features from other countries, including Britain, Ireland, Japan, USA, South Africa, Germany, Australia, and Canada. The Constituent Assembly of India was formed in 1946. It met for 166 days spread over 2 years, 11 months and 18 days. The Constitution of India is a hand-written document. It is one of the longest hand-written documents in the world. It is still open to interpretations and amendments in order to come true to the expectations of its people. At last he thanked all the officers, teachers and cadets for their active participation in the event and making the Seminar a success.
