Report

The event started with Tamil Thai Vazhthu and the College Prayer sung by the students of Defence and Strategic Studies. All the dignitaries, staff, researchers and the students were formally welcomed by the Dean, School of Humanities Dr.K.Shanthi. The Resource Person Col Lakshamana Kumar was facilitated by the Dr. Venkatasubramanian, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science. The student of B.A Defence and Strategic Studies Ms. Swarnapriya gave a brief introduction to the significance of the topic followed by the introduction of Chief Guest By Dr.O.Nirmala, Deputy- Dean School of Humanities.

The Resource Person Started with a brief introduction and history about Jammu and Kashmir. He also mentioned about the various rulers of Jammu and Kashmir from Kashyapa rishi to Dogra rulers before India got its independence. He narrated the whole situation about the integration of states at the time of partition and also highlighted the Instrument of Accession signed by the king Hari Singh of Jammu and Kashmir and the special status given to them under article 370. He gave an elaborated description about Article 370 and its six special provisions for Jammu and Kashmir. He also shared his view about various government initiatives for the abrogation of Article 370. He also clearly explained on what ground the government repealed Article 370? He gave his own experience regarding the situation prevailing in Jammu and Kashmir before Abrogation of article 370. He also made a clear difference between the socio, political, economic and military benefits before and after the abrogation of Article 370. Many students participated in the discussions and shared their views and clarified their doubts. The program concluded with Vote of Thanks by Mr.E.Horst Kharis, Assistant Professor MSW followed by the National Anthem.

Programme Objectives


The Objective of the Programme is
