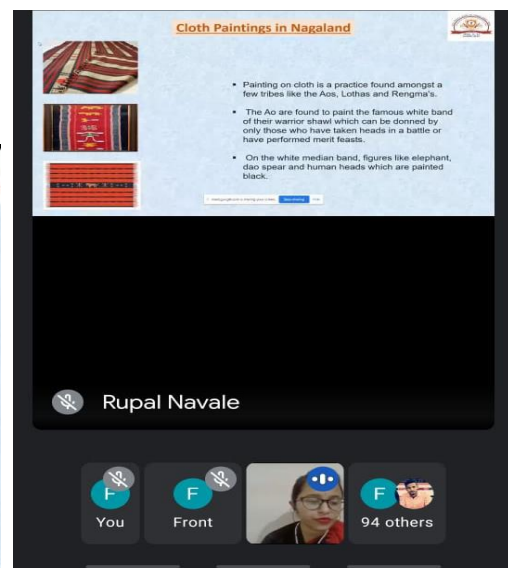

Weaving Technique of Nagaland



- Weaving is a traditional art handed down through generations in Nagaland.
- A number of traditions and beliefs are associated with the weaving and wearing of the traditional dress.
- It considered auspicious and had its traditional value and meaning.
- Most of the women in villages possess loom and the weaving is done on these looms.
- The loom-frames are used by women for traditional shawl-weaving while the narrow fly shuttle is used for shawl-weaving.
