WHAT IS LEADERSHIP?

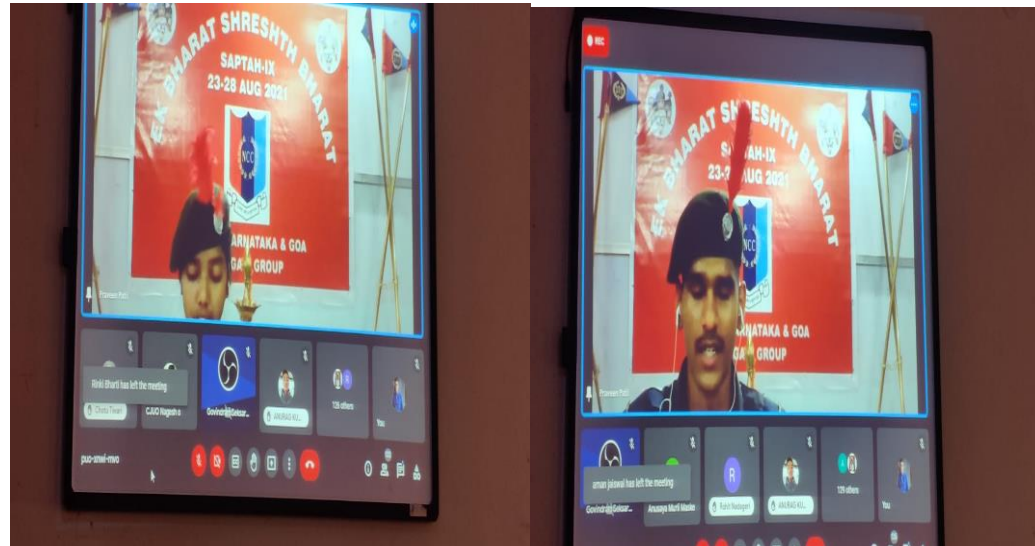

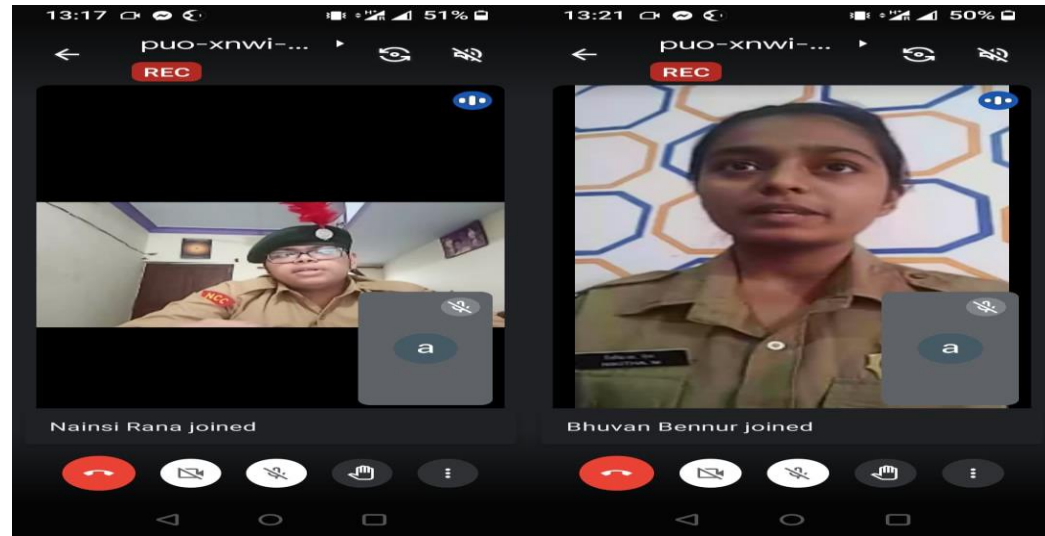

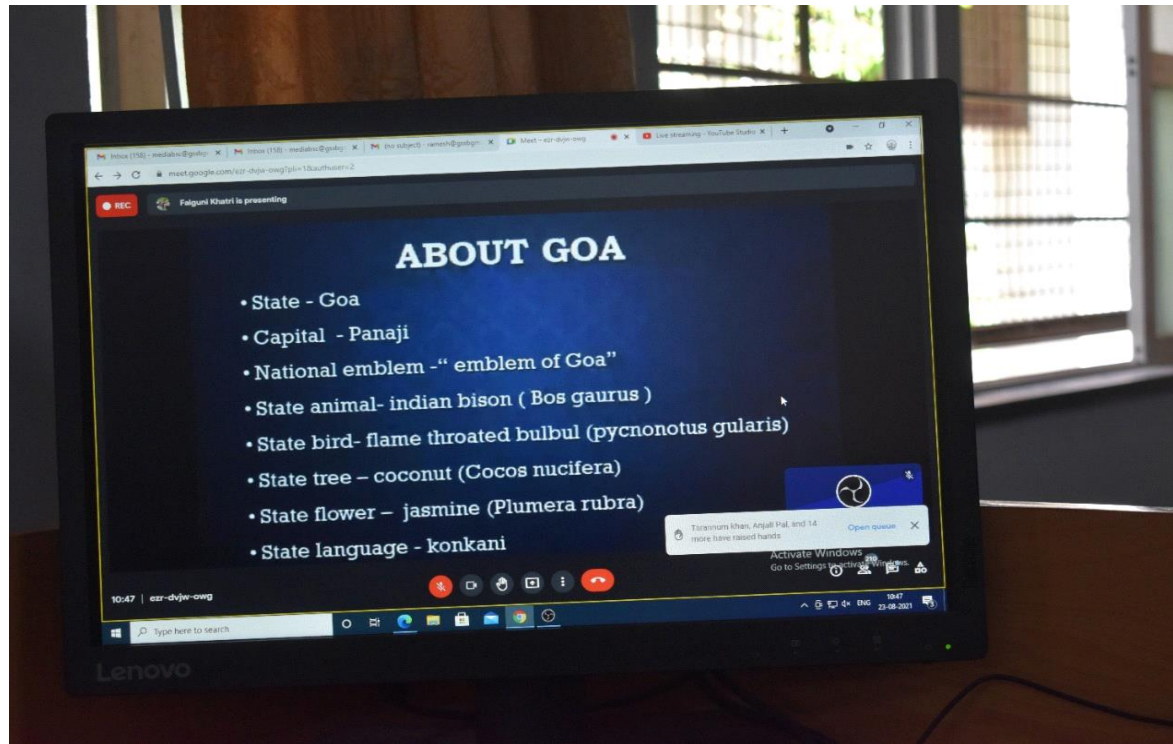
