Physical Infrastructure – Roads

Agencies maintaining roads in the state include the Public Works Department (PWD), panchayats, municipalities, corporations, the departments of forests, irrigation, railways and the Kerala State Electricity Board (KSEB).

PWD roads constitute 15.3 per cent of the total road network.

The Kerala State Transport Project (KSTP) was established in June 2002 to improve the 1,600 km of state roads and 77 km of inland-canal with the use of geographic information system.

As of May 2012, The Kerala State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) provides road transport services in Kerala and operates 6,092 buses.


