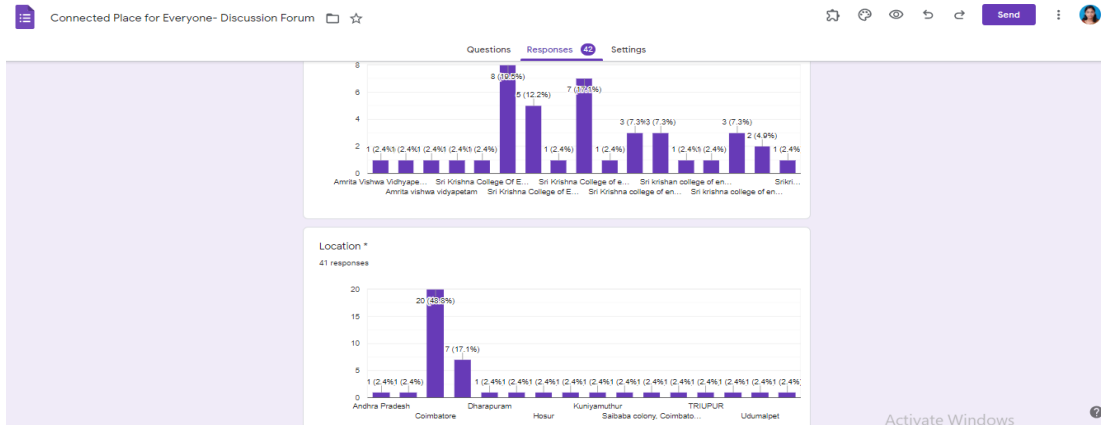












- Description of the event
