Brief Report

The Nepali song performance was given by Ms. Dipika Grace Chettri, Nepali Dept., Sikkim University. Mr. Sujay Singh, JNU read fundamental duties in Hindi and Ms. Dipika G. Chettri, Nepali Dept., Sikkim University presented the same in Nepali. The talk on "Sikkim Culture and Languages" was delivered by Dr. Balaram Pandey, Assistant Professor, Dept. 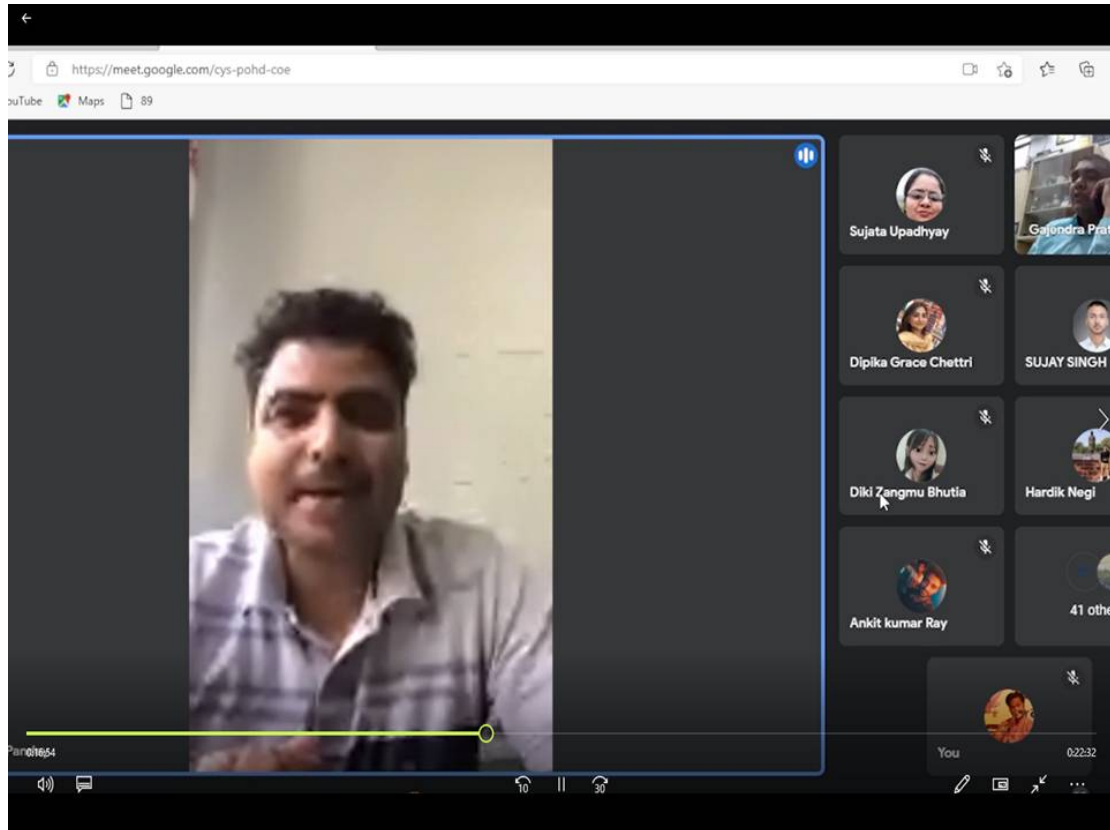
