The virtual programme began with Kulgeet of IGNOU.

Manikandan, student under RC Chennai highlighting the important food varieties especially Kanchipuram Idli, Garlic Rasam and Pongal and its nutritional values. Session – III: Important Tourism Destinations in the State of Tamil Nadu and Jammu & Kashmir


