



## Report for Khasi language online session program

#### Introduction:

The Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat committee of Jaipuria Institute of Management Noida conducted a brilliant online session on Khasi language recently. The Khasi language in native Meghalaya formed an important part of this educational system, aimed at promoting cultural understanding and national integration.
