

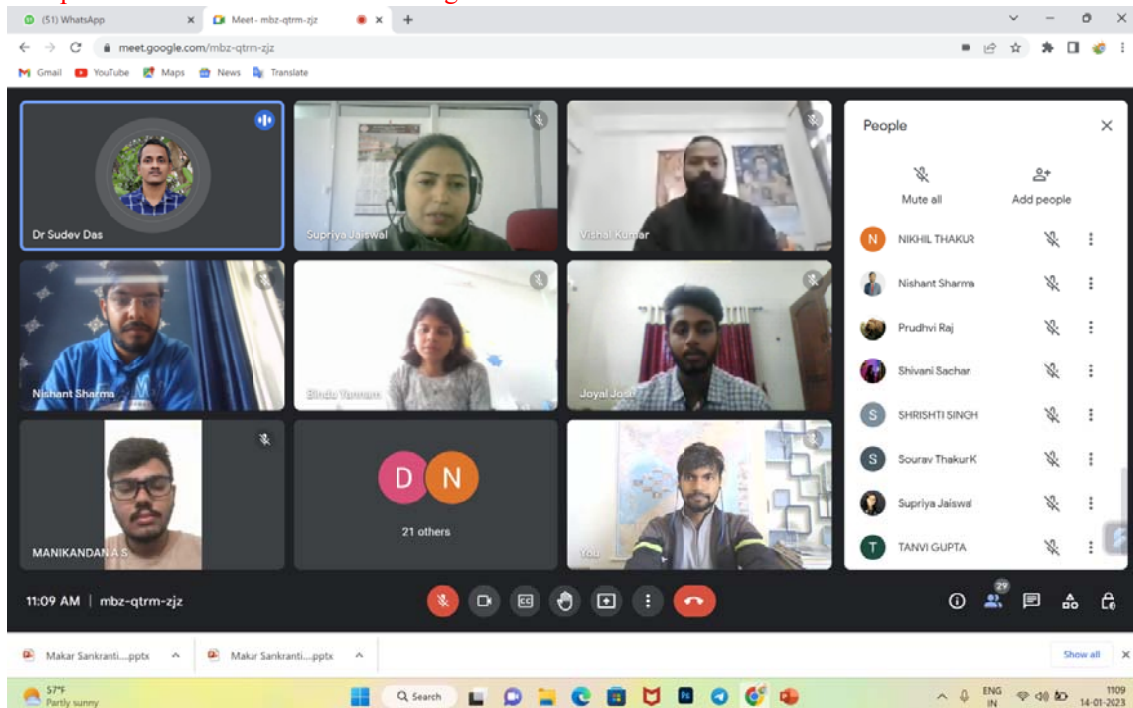
Report : Celebration of Makar Sankranti as a part of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat

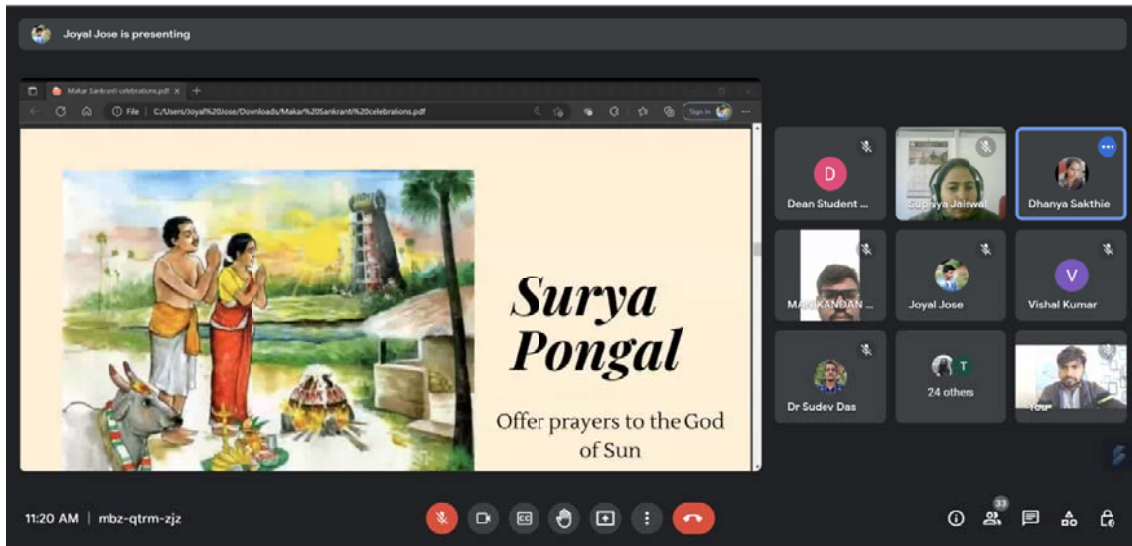
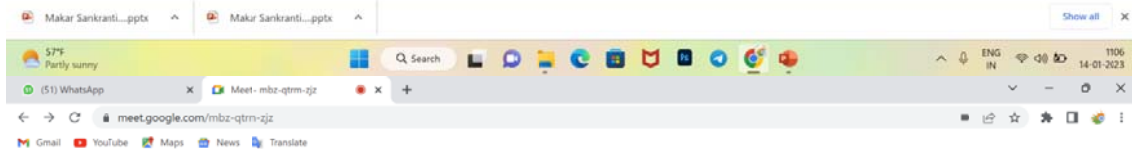
